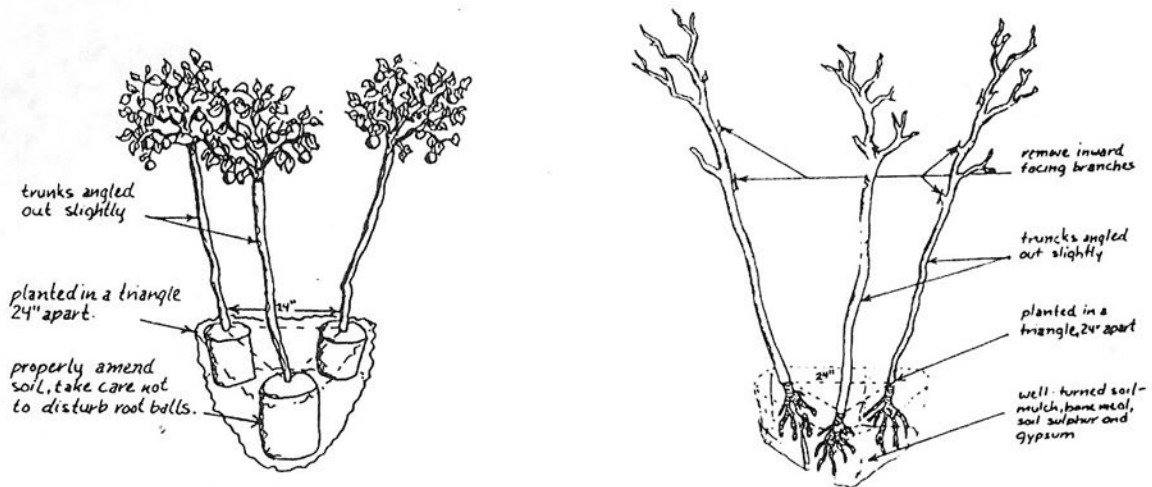

You can produce three different Fruit Tree crops in slightly more than the space of one tree.

The Trees should be planted in a triangle 24" apart at a slight outward angle. The center limbs are pruned so that crossing limbs are removed, otherwise normal care is all that is necessary.



You will gain several advantages using this method of planting:

1. Better Pollination
2. Extended ripening times
3. Better production than multiple budded single trees

You can have all your favorite fruit in a much smaller area. For example:

- \*Brown, Black, White figs in one group
- \*Tangerine, Orange, Grapefruit in one group
- \*Early May, Mid May and June Peaches in one group

As long as the Trees are similar in size and shape, mix and match to your hearts content.
