

Sensory Gardens

<i>Acacia smallii</i> – Sweet acacia.	Has very fragrant yellow puff-ball flowers in the spring. (Note: This tree does have thorns, so it would need to be lifted over head level.)
<i>Aloysia triphylla</i> – Lemon verbena.	The leaves of this shrub smell and taste like lemons.
<i>Chrysactinia mexicana</i> – Damianita.	This small shrub has very aromatic foliage.
<i>Hyptis emoryi</i> – Desert lavender.	A large, narrow shrub with a pungent fragrance.
<i>Larrea tridentate</i> – Creosote.	What a heavenly fragrance after summer rains!
<i>Leucophyllum laevigatum</i> – Chihuahuan sage.	The flowers of this shrub provide a delicate scent in the late summer and early fall.
<i>Leucophyllum pruinatum</i> – Sierra Bouquet™.	This shrub blooms in the summer and fall with flowers that smell like grape bubble gum.
<i>Muhlenbergia capillaries</i> – Regal Mist™.	The narrow leaves of this ornamental grass are slick and waxy. It also has plumes of soft, misty flowers in the fall months.
<i>Osmanthus fragrans</i> – Sweet olive.	The tiny flowers on this shrub have an incredibly sweet fragrance!
<i>Sophora secundiflora</i> – Texas mountain laurel.	This large shrub/small tree has clusters of purple flowers that smell like grape bubble gum.
<i>Salvia clevelandii</i> – Chaparral sage.	This large shrub has very aromatic foliage.
<i>Tagetes lemmonii</i> – Mount Lemmon marigold.	This shrub has extremely aromatic foliage.
